Talking Pictures THE BISHOP'S WIFE (1947)

Lesser-known than 'It's a wonderful life' but in some ways more enjoyable. The Bishop's Wife, whilst set at Christmastime, can be appreciated at any time of the year with its uplifting story of selfaffirmation and family life. Later turned into a stage musical (by my good self) and even getting a Motown facelift in the 90s with Denzel Washington and the late Whitney Houston, the monochrome original is a minor classic, featuring an 'angel' sent to Earth ('Wonderful Life' style) to offer Bishop David Niven guidance. Ostensibly his problem is the building of a new cathedral, financed by mean spirited widow Gladys Cooper, who insists that it be built her way. Among the many stand out lines is when she insists that the statue of St. George conquering the dragon has the countenance of her late husband, and the Bishop 'innocently' asks 'and who should the dragon represent?'. Of course the 'wife', played by Loretta Young, is being somewhat forsaken due to this major project and under extreme pressure one day the Bishop prays for guidance, only to be visited by the angel 'Dudley', mischievously played by the incomparable Cary Grant, who proceeds to charm everyone he meets and set a path for an uplifting denouement. The film's strength lies with a plot in which the audience is 'in' on the secret, but the cast are not - we all know that an innocent angel would never come between the Bishop and his wife - although Niven at one point is ready to fight Dudley as he suspects

the worst after another 'innocent' date, only to be told by Dudley he was merely 'representing **him** with his wife' thereby allowing the Bishop to undertake the more important stuff! There is ice skatina in Central Park, a comedy relief taxi driver (James Gleason) and a kindly old history professor, whose 'donation' to the church fund of an old Roman coin he once excavated turns out to be much more valuable than he thought (thanks to Dudley's unsurprising knowledge of history). 'You speak French so well' he is complimented -'I've done a lot of work there' he replies! And another favourite line, when the Professor tells the Bishop 'Dudley knows more about history than I do' with the reply 'He should do- he's been at it longer!' Sweet without ever being saccharine, and deep without the darkness, 'The Bishop's Wife' deserves a wider audience, although it has started to appear across the channels in more recent years. Catch it if you can I'll leave you with my own favourite line as the angel Dudley sorts through the Bishop's private post and is asked sarcastically by Niven 'are you expecting a letter' and the killer reply - 'well if I should get one, the stamp will be worth keeping!'.

ARKENGARTHDALE PARISH COUNCIL November 2020

Highways:

<u>Culvert near Langthwaite</u>: Following the removal of obstructions, an inspection had been carried out and the culvert was in excellent condition. There was a need for the entry to the culvert to be widened in order for it to cope with large volumes of water. NYCC would be made aware of this. <u>Footbridges</u>: It was noted that NYCC had not as yet made progress with reinstating the foot bridges at Woodhouse and Punchard. NYCC would be contacted.

<u>Potholes:</u> Highways had put tarmac in the potholes in Arkle Town and Langthwaite.

Notification from Highways: There would be changes to traffic management at the flood damaged bridge at Cogden Beck on the B6270. The information would be placed on the notice-board.

Chippings on Stang Lane: Recent rain had washed out the repairs to the roadsides on Stang Lane and the road surface was now heavily covered in chippings and was hazardous. Highways would be informed.

Other road matters: The ingress of water from the roadside at Moor Edge was again raised, along with the issue of excess surface water on Bouldershaw Lane, which would be dangerous if allowed to freeze during winter. Highways did not agree to take responsibility for these.

Seat maintenance/repairs: Alan Richardson and Steve Coleman were offering to refurbish and/or repair the public seats in the dale for a small fee. The

owners of the seats would be contacted and informed about this opportunity. The Parish Council's 'Jubilee' seat in Langthwaite would be repaired and refurbished.

Access across High Green: A response had been received from the new owners of Scar View, acknowledging the Parish Council's request to keep the access road clear and clarifying the contact details of the owners.

Renovation of petrol pumps at Arkle Town: An application to the YDNPA Sustainable Development Fund could be submitted by the Parish Council for 75% of the costs of the renovation work. If successful an information board would need to be erected next to the pumps as a condition of the grant. This would be at the expense of the Parish Council. Clarification was requested about the terms of the grant and any necessary planning requirements to place an information board on private land.

Christmas Lights: The Christmas lights would be put up on High Green on Saturday 5 December if the weather permitted.

Planning: The following planning decisions were noted: i) Low Seal House, Arkengarthdale R/01/166: application approved conditionally: ii) Whaw Village, Arkengarthdale R/01/132C/OH from Northern PowerGrid (North East) Plc for replacement poles and conductors: application approved no objections. The following planning application was considered: Low Lock Slack Cottage, (continued on next page)

Arkengarthdale R/01/167 for the erection of a two-storey extension and replacement windows. Councillors agreed a flat roof and bay windows were not in keeping surrounding properties. It was also noted that the proposed top-floor window would overlook the neighbouring property.

Something more in keeping and less intrusive would be recommended to Planning.



Swaledale Night Sky



The night sky is pretty much a black and white affair.....apart from the sickly orange glow of light pollution. This is mainly due to the poor colour sensitivity of our eyes under low light conditions. However, there are a few objects that do show colour relatively easily. The diagram shows the night sky to the south at about 21:00 this January. Mars, to the South East, is orangey/red. Its surface has lots of iron oxide. More commonly found in rust on Earth. Betelgeuse is a red giant star. It is the top left (north east) star above the distinctive 3 stars of Orion's Belt. Orangey/red as it is so large that the outer reaches of its atmosphere are relatively cool at ~4700C. Last winter it dimmed to be the same brightness as the star on the opposite shoulder (Bellatrix), prompting ominous predictions of an imminent supernova. It returned to normal brightness through late winter/early spring as a dust cloud moved out of the way.

Aldebaran is another red giant. It is the eye of the bull, Taurus, and can be seen between Betelgeuse and Mars. Rigel is a hot blue/white star. It is the bottom right (south west) star below Orion's Belt. Its surface temperature is \sim 12000C, toasty!

Finally, the star Sirius can be found way down left of Orion's Belt. The brightest star in our night sky. A blue/white star, it usually exhibits a whole rainbow of colours as its light is bent and split, prism-like, during its passage through the turbulent thick layer of the earth's atmosphere low down near the horizon.





60 Drones Could Supply 5G To The Entire UK

This article may bore some as its technology focused

I have been working with 5G globally and Robotic Manufacturing. The BBC released a story this week about how just 60 hydrogen-powered Drones hovering could supply the entire UK with fast wireless internet. That would be useful for many in these areas.

t is estimated that the speed would be such that we could download a 4GB Movie in under 6 minutes.

The drone proposals are at drawing board stage but two companies Stratospheric Platforms and Cambridge Consultants are seriously looking at this.

The drones would hover in position at 65,617 feet (20,000m). Much higher than commercial aircraft fly. Their wingspan would be approximately 200 feet whereas as a comparison the wingspan of a 747 Jumbo Jet was 224 feet.

If we were to use 5G masts instead of drones, it is estimated that it would taken 200 (ugly intrusive) masts to provide the same coverage as one drone. That means 60×200 masts = 12,000 masts across the UK.

Of course safety is a concern if we were to have large drones hovering in place constantly.

Google are looking at a similar idea where they would use solar-powered high-altitude-balloons.


