



Sustainable Swaledale

Cherish chives, love lovage & savour sage

Reeth Surgery community beds have lots of herbs available for everyone to use. Just a few leaves are great at giving a dish an extra zing and are full of vitamins

Not come across the herb before? Check the labels to identify it and try a leaf to see if you like it. Most can be nipped off with your fingers so no need to have any special equipment. A few are described in detail below:

The beds have both common chives (smaller and milder) and garlic chives (larger and stronger). The stalks can be cut with scissors or just pinched off with fingers. Chives are best used uncooked so add to dishes just before serving. Use in garnishes, salads, egg mayonnaise, soups, creamy sauces, potato dishes and omelettes. The young flowers are also edible. Just break up the head into florets and use to garnish a salad.

Check out a spicy oregano and a lemon oregano which can be added to pasta sauces. If you are after a lemony taste, lemon balm (a member of the mint family) can be shredded to add flavour to salads and drink or cook in soups and sauces.

under increasing pressure from climate change and population growth and energy usage for heating water accounts for 17% of an average household's consumption. Specific proposals that will be introduced over the next few years include:

- Mandatory water efficiency labels on new white goods such as washing machines and showers
- Requiring water companies to improve on fixing customer supply pipe leakage
- Encouraging local authorities to incentivise property developers to install more efficient fittings by setting a tighter standard of 110 litres per person per day (currently 1251)
- Looking at greater water efficiency in new developments and retrofits

by use of rainwater harvesting, water reuse and storage.

Additional areas have been added to the list of those suffering water stress and although North Yorkshire is not currently designated as such, we can't be complacent and it is likely that should national water usage restrictions be introduced, we would be impacted.



The Canadian behemoth which came out in 2013 seems to have taken over many a family TV or Tablet screen. They make their big screen debut in the unexpectedly titled "Paw Patrol: The Movie on August 13th to the delight of parents everywhere.

If you don't already know about the heroics of the Paw Patrol (perhaps lucky you), it's a computer animated kids' series which follows a young lad named Ryder who leads a team of 'search & rescue' pups to protect Adventure Bay.
